

VOLUNTEER FORM Dance Recital - June 8th & 9th, 2019

DEADLINE ASAP or before May 2nd

- All volunteers get priority seating for their family at ticket sales and get into the show they are volunteering in for free.
- Group volunteers only receive a complimentary ticket for the show(s) they are volunteering for and must purchase a ticket for the shows they are NOT a volunteer for.
- Volunteers are required to attend dress rehearsal to meet with their class and to participate in the rehearsal process – (don't worry, you will get a chance to take plenty of pictures and videos at this rehearsal).
- **Limited spots are available for volunteers per class, so turn in this form ASAP! Volunteers are first come, first serve.**

GROUP VOLUNTEER (If your dancer is performing in only 1 routine in the show)

1. Meet your class to check-in dancer at their assigned seats (shown to you at dress rehearsal). An usher will grab you and your class a few numbers ahead of time to take you backstage.
2. You may then watch the performance up close from the wings of the stage, and then an usher will help you and your class back to your seats to watch the remainder of the show.
3. After the show, dancers' parents will check-out their dancer from you at your assigned seats. After all dancers are checked out, your volunteer help is over.

With 200+ routines, we need 200+ group volunteers. Please parents -- talk amongst yourselves in the waiting room and select a volunteer from your class. Please turn in volunteer forms ASAP to the front desk to get VIP seating for your family. Thank you!

DRESSING ROOM VOLUNTEER (If your dancer is performing in more than 1 routine in the same show)

1. You will report backstage to help welcome your dancers and get their costumes ready for their multiple routines.
2. You will help dancers in more than one number change their costumes. **Moms**, we will be calling you for this job if we do not have enough help! (Especially if your dancer is in more than one number in the same show.)
3. You will not be able to see the full show from the audience, but you may still watch your child's number from the wings.
